Eligibility requirements: The Haggerty Scholars Program is for current high school juniors (graduating in 2016) with an interest in law and civil rights. Students must be willing to spend time working with an attorney mentor, visiting a legal workplace for a week-long visit during the summer, and attending the annual Federal Bar Association dinner on May 28, 2015 with a parent or teacher.
